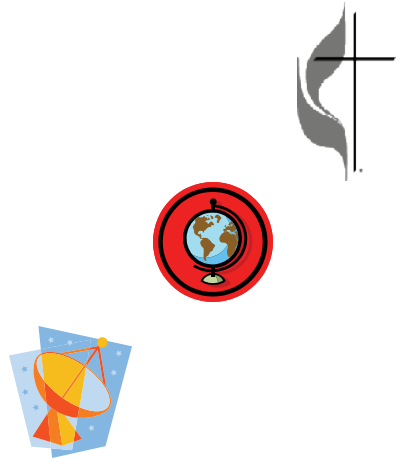

Your Resource Center in the 21st Century

As we go forward into this new millennium, we realize that the church must keep up with the changes that take place moment by moment. Models for Christian Education and Spiritual Formation are changing to meet the demands and needs of people of all ages in our churches. Worship trends are changing rapidly along with finding resources to promote opportunities for mission projects, revivals, and social justice.

Your resource center endeavors to keep up with these challenges by purchasing resources for educational and spiritual development.

Resource Center FAQ's:

Q: Is there a fee to borrow a resource?

A: There is currently no fee for UM churches to borrow resources. The only cost is the return postage if the resource is mailed to you.

Q: How long can I keep a resource?

A: Depending on the length of the study, as many weeks as it takes to complete the course of study. In most cases of single video usage, you can keep the video for 10 days beginning from the day you receive it, until you return it. Please contact us if you feel you need to keep it for an extended period of time.

Resource Center Ministries:

- **provide spiritual and educational resources that appeal to all ages**
- **research and resource opportunities for pastors to maintain spiritual health and growth that are offered within our denomination and elsewhere**
- **personnel that can help a pastor or lay person with information and insight when choosing a resource to use for their program needs**
- **Involved in protecting churches by purchasing videos with public performance rights. That is, most resources within the collection of our media libraries have rights that will allow them to be shown within your church setting. Resource Center personnel are familiar with the law and can advise a church about public performance rights.**
- **maintain a human resource bank that will provide leadership in areas of mission and ministry.**
